### **FIREFIGHTER RECRUITMENT**

The Arcata Fire District is using the Firefighter Candidate Testing Center (FCTC) Statewide Eligibility List (SEL) to fill **ONE Full Time Career Firefighter Position**. - FCTC Statewide Eligibility List (SEL): Candidates applying for a position with Arcata Fire District must be **Active** on the FCTC SEL on June 26, 2019. Candidates must meet minimum qualifications to be placed on the SEL which include but are not limited to passing the FCTC Written Test and Cal-JAC CPAT. ### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AT TIME OF APPOINTMENT**

- CSFM - Firefighter I Certified (**FF1 academy only will not qualify**)
- Possess a current, valid California or National Registry EMT-1 or Paramedic certification (note: persons possessing a National Registry Certification will be required to register as a California EMT-1 or Paramedic prior to appointment).
- Valid California Class "C" Driver's License with a clean driving record.
- U.S. Citizen, eligible to work in the United States
- Must have High School Diploma or G.E.D.
- Must be 18 years or older

## ABOUT THE DISTRICT

- The District covers **3 stations** each staffed with one FF and one Captain
- Employees work a **48/96** or 2 on 4 off schedule
- The Arcata Fire District is protects **37,000 residents** living amongst industrial, commercial, residential, agricultural, beaches, and Wildland Urban Interface areas.
- We are located on the remote and isolated coast of Northern California and protect the City of Arcata, the communities of McKinleyville, Bayside, Manila, Jacoby Creek and other rural areas for a total service area of 62 square miles.

## BENEFITS

- Represented by the International Association of Firefighters Local 4981 Labor Agreement
- Retirement – PERS (3% at 55 for classic/ 2.7% at 57 for new). The District is not a Social Security Agency, and no deductions will be made for Social Security.
- Medical – The Districts workers' compensation coverage, medical, dental, and vision coverage for employees and eligible dependents is provided. District pays the total contribution until retirement or termination.
- Vacation – Vacation is accumulated at 6 shifts per year after the first year and increases with time in service. The maximum accrual is 20 shifts.
- Sick Leave – Sick Leave is accrued at ½ shift per month with no limit. Up to three shifts of Family Sick Leave are also allowed per fiscal year and are deducted from employee's accrued sick leave.
- Holidays – The District pays for 8 shifts in lieu of holidays worked.
- Life Insurance – The District pays the premium on a life insurance policy for employees.
- Additional Benefits – Other benefits include a deferred compensation program, uniform allowance, short term disability insurance, and a corporate family membership in an air ambulance program.

***DO NOT attach a resume; you will have an opportunity to provide a resume and other documentation if you are selected to proceed to the Oral Interview.***

## TESTING PROCESS

This testing process will include an Oral Board, Chief's Interview, Background Investigator interview, and 4-6 hour ride along.

**ORAL BOARD** – Qualifying candidates will be invited to an Oral Board on one of the following dates: June 17, 18, or 19, 2019. Candidates should bring a current resume to the Oral Board. Candidates will be notified of their interview time through email. Candidates must provide a current email address to receive this communication.

**CHIEF'S INTERVIEW** – The **top three** passing candidates from the Oral Board will be invited to a Chief's interview on July 22 or 23, 2019. Candidates will be notified of their interview time through email communication.

**BACKGROUND INVESTIGATOR INTERVIEW** - If candidates are selected by the Fire Chief, they will go directly to an interview with a Background Investigator. Candidates **MUST BRING A COMPLETED BACKGROUND PACKET** to the Chief's interview to continue.

**RIDE-ALONG** - Following the Chief's interview, candidates will be invited to participate in a ride along with the on duty crew for 4-6 hours.
