

## City of Dixon - Fire Department Recruitment Announcement



The City of Dixon Fire Department is seeking applicants to fill current vacancies for the position of **Entry and Lateral Firefighter/Paramedic**.

To be considered eligible for Firefighter/Paramedic you must meet the following criteria:

- Pass the Firefighter Candidate Testing Center (FCTC) Entry Level Firefighter Written Exam and be placed on the FCTC Statewide Eligibility List.
- Possess a current, valid Cal-JAC CPAT Card issued within the last 12 months from date of application submission and ability to pass the City of Dixon's aerial ladder agility test.
- A minimum of 12 months of current and continuous experience as a full time/career firefighter with no separation time or break in service at time of application for Lateral.
- Possession of a current, valid Mobile Intensive Care Paramedic license meeting the requirements of the California Emergency Medical Services Authority.
- Possession of a California State Fire Marshal Firefighter I Certificate.
- Possession of a current, valid Advanced Cardiac Life Support certificate issued by the American Heart Association or the equivalent. (Pediatric advanced life support & basic trauma life support or international trauma life support)
- Ability to possess Solano County Paramedic Accreditation within three (3) months of initial hire.
- A Firefighter Class C Endorsement and maintain clean driving record

From applications received, the City will pull a list from FCTC and then schedule a skills test and interview process with the most qualified candidates whose applications indicate they, among those competing, are better qualified in terms of related training and experience. The application pull date from FCTC will be <u>the first week of every month</u>.
