Classification: Firefighter/Paramedic (open and continuous recruitment)

Annual compensation: \$71,931 - \$96,906

THE POSITION

Under the general supervision of the Fire Captain, the Firefighter/Paramedic position will perform firefighting and fire prevention duties aimed at protecting life and property; will operate and maintain a variety of advanced lifesaving equipment; responds to emergency medical calls and provides advanced lifesaving measures to the sick and injured; and will perform other duties as assigned, in accordance with District policy. The Firefighter/Paramedic will be expected to conduct themselves proficiently and professionally while assigned as a team member to an ambulance or a fire engine. Additionally, the position is subject to a 12-month probationary period.

THE DISTRICT

The El Dorado County Fire Protection District is an independent Special District in El Dorado County responsible for providing a high level of emergency and non-emergency services along the Highway 50 corridor to the communities of Camino, Coloma, Cool, Pilot Hill, City of Placerville, Pleasant Valley, Pollock Pines, Shingle Springs, Silver Fork, and Strawberry. The District is protected by 5 staffed fire stations, and 73 full-time firefighters. Financial oversight and strategic policy direction are provided by an elected 5-member Board of Directors.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must possess a high school diploma or GED
- Must possess a valid CDL with a driver record acceptable to the District
- A valid Health Care Provider CPR certificate/card from the AHA
- Must possess a valid State of California Paramedic license or National Registry Paramedic Certification (NRP)
- All new employees shall not use tobacco products on or off duty as a term of employment
- Must possess a valid Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) issued after January 1, 2020
- Current ACLS, PALS, and PHTLS certificate

COMPENSATION

- Annual compensation - \$71,931 - \$96,906 (Includes Holiday, FLSA, Uniform, Longevity Pay)
- An additional 3% educational incentive is available for all employees possessing either a BA/BS degree

BENEFITS

- Public Employees Retirement System 2.7% @ 57 for new members of CALPERS, or 2% @ 50 for those with former CALPERS qualified employment with a break-in service of less than six months
- Health insurance plans through a variety of providers with a monthly District contribution towards premiums that reflect the following:
 - Employee only - \$725.00
 - Employee + 1 dependent - \$1,350.00
 - Employee + family - \$1,700.00
- Additional dental, vision, long-term disability and life insurance coverage provided
- Annual vacation leave - starting at 144 per year, increasing with years of service
- Annual sick leave - 144 hours per year

SELECTION PROCESS

In order to participate in this examination process, candidates **MUST** be on the FCTC statewide eligibility list by time of application.

- 1) Submit an El Dorado County Fire Protection District application and resume outlining your qualifications, with a cover letter attached. An application can be obtained at www.eldoradocountyfire.com. Return the above requested information to the District administrative office in person at 4040 Carson Road, Camino, CA 95709, or mail to P.O. Box 807, Camino CA 95709. Resumes will not be accepted as a substitute for any part of the application. Failure to complete all required information in the application process may result in your disqualification from the testing process.
- 2) All applications will be reviewed for completion, relevant education, training, experience, and other job-related qualifications. Those who best meet the stated qualifications and requirements for the position will be invited to participate in the selection process, which will consist of the following:
 - Oral Interview
 - Paramedic skills-based scenario
 - Interview with Fire Chief
- 3) Candidates being considered for employment must successfully complete a pre-employment physical exam, drug and alcohol screening, and a background investigation.
