Application Period:

Applications will be accepted from December 2, 2019 to January 24, 2020 at the Nevada County Consolidated Fire District Administrative Office at 640 Coyote Street, Nevada City, CA. 95959. Applications may be dropped off in person from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday through Friday, submitted by mail and postmarked between, December 2, 2019 to January 24, 2020 or submitted electronically as an attachment to nccfire@nccfire.com.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be active on the Firefighter Candidate Testing Center's (FCTC) Statewide Eligibility List (SEL) on January 24, 2020. To view the SEL requirements, please visit FCTCOnline.org.
- Must have Cal-JAC CPAT card dated between January 24, 2019 – January 24, 2020 and pass the FCTC Written Test between January 24, 2019 – January 24, 2020.
- Valid unrestricted California Driver's License. Ability to obtain a CDL valid for operation of fire apparatus within six-months of appointment.
- At least 18 years of age on the date of application.
- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Successful completion of an accredited California State Fire Marshal Firefighter I Academy; and / or 3 years' full-time experience in an organized, all risk fire agency. Cumulative seasonal employment, or combination thereof equaling 3 years shall qualify.
- Valid CSFM Firefighter I certificate or letter on agency letterhead and signed by a Captain or Chief Officer verifying the experience requirement for CSFM Firefighter I certification by January 1, 2020.
- CPR
- Valid California or National Registry Emergency Medical Technician
- Ability to pass a comprehensive background investigation, pre-placement medical screening, including a drug screen.
- Review Job Description for additional information.

Desirable Qualifications:

- Associate's or higher-level degree from an accredited college or university.
- California Driver's License valid for operating fire apparatus.
- CSFM Driver Operator 1A, 1B.

Filing Information:

All candidates shall submit the following documentation in the order listed during the application period. Incomplete or out of order submissions will be rejected:

- Signed, completed employment application,
- Current resume (1),
- Certificate of successful completion of CSFM Accredited Fire Academy and/or verification of 3 years' full-time experience.
- Valid CSFM Firefighter I certificate, or a letter on agency letterhead and signed by a Captain or Chief Officer verifying the experience requirement for CSFM Firefighter I certification being met by January 24, 2020.
- Current California or National Registry Emergency Medical Technician Certification.
- CPR
- Current (within 30 days) DMV driving record.
- A valid Physical Ability Test (CPAT) Card, administered by California Firefighter Joint Apprenticeship Committee issued within 12 months prior to January 24, 2020.

Selection Process:

In order to participate in this examination process, candidates MUST be on the FCTC Statewide Eligibility List and submit the above filing information by Friday, January 24, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.

Filing information will be screened to verify minimum qualifications. Minimum qualifications must be met at the time of application submission. An application review will be conducted, and the top qualified applicants may be invited to participate in the next phase of the selection process. Meeting the minimum qualifications does not guarantee an invitation to further steps in this process.
